



Indiana Health Information Exchange (IHIE) – Indiana’s COVID-19 Data Resource

Indiana Health Information Exchange (IHIE) implemented a number of critical services as the COVID-19 data resource. These services include:

- Notifiable Condition Detector – Sends daily alerts of positive and negative COVID-19 tests from labs to public health departments.
- Visual Data Dashboard – Provides data to populate dashboard that displays counts of patients who are confirmed or suspected positive for COVID-19 and related conditions.
- Population-Level Surveillance Reporting – Produces daily reports for State public health that contain registration events and relevant clinical information for population who tested positive.
- Results Delivery Communication to Hospitals – Processes near real-time messages from for COVID-19 test lab results and distributing to hospitals that collected original specimen.

IHIE has played a vital role in the coordination of a statewide response to COVID-19, according to John Kansky, IHIE CEO. “I think Indiana’s response has demonstrated the great assets of our state *and* our Midwestern ability to work together and get stuff done when it truly matters,” Kansky said.
